WALT: Write an Acrostic poem with a Travelwise theme

Definition:

A poem is a piece of creative writing that expresses thoughts, feelings and ideas. Some poems rhyme whereas others are non-rhyming and use words that form images (pictures) in your mind.

Acrostic Poem

An acrostic is a form of poetry where you use the letters in a word to create the poem. Each letter adds a line to the poem and tells a story.

Example:

Helmet covers my head.
Ears are safe and sound.
Lucky to have safety gear.
Making the most of my freedom.
Everyone watching as I fly down the street on my bike.
Traffic passing by.
