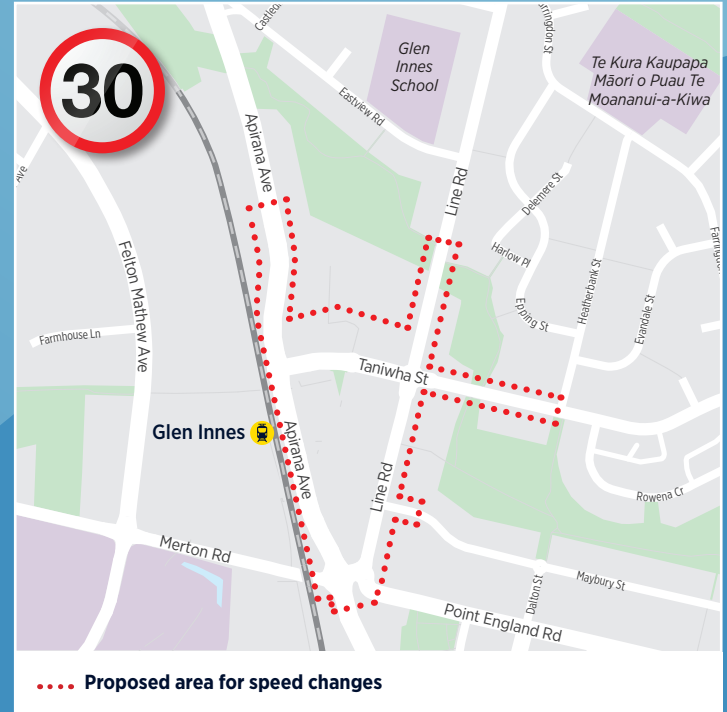
Feedback is due by 3 April 2022
