# Auckland Transport would like your feedback on proposed changes for some North Shore bus services.

We propose to change nine existing services, and introduce one brand new service.

The changes would aim to make it quicker and easier for you to travel around the North Shore and the rest of Auckland by public transport.

- More direct bus routes to take you to Rosedale Station where you'll be able to change to the frequent Northern Busway services.
- More bus routes to serve the North Harbour Industrial Estate.
- Some residential areas to be served by buses for the first time.

Any changes to bus services would be made when Rosedale Station (a new Northern Busway station) opens, which is currently planned for 2025.

#### Some of the proposed changes are minor.

Buses that use the Northern Busway would stop at Rosedale Station in addition to all the other Northern Busway stations. <NX1> - Hibiscus Coast Station, Albany Station, all Northern Busway stations, Lower Albert Street.

<NX2> - Hibiscus Coast Station, Albany Station, all Northern Busway stations, Wellesley Street, city universities.

<866> - Albany Station, all Northern Busway stations, Ponsonby Road, Karangahape Road, Auckland City Hospital, Newmarket.

Buses that currently use the part of Rosedale Road that will become part of Rosedale Station would stop at the new station.

<884> - North Harbour Industrial Estate loop -Constellation Station, Apollo Drive, Triton Drive, Rosedale Road.

<885> - North Harbour Industrial Estate loop - Constellation Station, William Pickering Drive, Rosedale Road.

# Significant changes are proposed for four existing services.

# The <865> would be re-routed from Albany Station to Rosedale Station and Massey University.

Browns Bay and Oaktree Avenue would have a more direct connection with the Northern Busway at Rosedale Station, and therefore quicker journeys to and from the city centre and other parts of the North Shore.

The 865 would also give people a more direct bus service for travelling between the Northern Busway and Massey University. McClymonts Road would be served by the 889 bus service.

#### Buses from Browns Bay would run

- Monday to Friday, from 6am until 10:30pm, every 15 minutes at peak commuting times and every 30 minutes at all other times.
- Weekends and public holidays, from 6:30am until 10pm, every 30 minutes.

#### Buses from Massey University would run

- Monday to Friday, from 7am until midnight, every 15 minutes at peak commuting times and every 30 minutes at all other times.
- Weekends and public holidays, from 7:30am until midnight, every 30 minutes.


# The <883> would be re-routed to serve the North Harbour Industrial Estate.

Following the introduction of traffic lights at the Rothwell Avenue and Albany Highway intersection, we can

provide a safe bus connection between Schnapper Rock and the North Harbour Industrial Estate.

Running the 883 along Rothwell Avenue and Paul Matthews Road (instead of Upper Harbour Highway as at present) would make it easier for people to travel to and from this part of the North Harbour Industrial Estate by bus.

Buses from Schnapper Rock would run every 30 minutes:

Monday to Friday from 6am until 9pm

Weekends and public holidays from 7am until 9pm

Buses from Constellation Station would run every 30 minutes:


- Monday to Friday from 6:45am until 9:15pm
- Weekends and public holidays from 7:15am until 9:15pm

# The <889> would be re-routed from Apollo Drive and Constellation Station to Rosedale Station.

People on Hugh Green Drive would have a more direct connection with the Northern Busway at Rosedale Station, and therefore quicker journeys to and from the city centre and other parts of the North Shore.

Apollo Drive would be served by the 907 bus service.

#### Buses from Albany Station would run:

- Monday to Friday, from 6am until 10pm, every 20 minutes at peak commuting times and every 30 minutes at all other times.
- Weekends and public holidays, from 7am until 10pm, every 30 minutes.

#### Buses from Rosedale Station would run:

- Monday to Friday, from 6:30am until 10:30pm, every 20 minutes at peak commuting times and every 30 minutes at all other times.
- Weekends and public holidays, from 7:30am until 10:30pm, every 30 minutes.

# The <907> would be extended from Mairangi Bay, along Maxwelton Drive and Apollo Drive to Rosedale Station.

This change would make it easier for people to travel to and from the Mairangi Bay shops by bus, and ensure that Apollo Drive was still served by buses.

#### Buses from Rosedale Station would run:

- Monday to Friday, from 5am until 10:30pm, every 20 minutes at peak commuting times and every 30 minutes at all other times.
- Weekends and public holidays, from 6am until 11pm, every 60 minutes.

#### Buses from Constellation Station would run:


- Monday to Friday, from 6:15am until 11:15pm, every 20 minutes at peak commuting times and every 30 minutes at all other times.
- Weekends and public holidays, from 6:45am until 10:45pm, every 60 minutes

## A brand new bus service is proposed – the <864>.

The 864 would give Browns Bay a direct connection with the Northern Busway at Rosedale Station, and therefore quicker journeys to and from the city centre and other parts of the North Shore.

This new service would run the length of Browns Bay Road and Rosedale Road, making it easier to travel to and from neighbouring residential areas and the North Harbour Industrial Estate. The 864 would give Albany Village another connection with the Northern Busway at Rosedale Station, and a connection with the East Coast Bays.

#### Buses from Browns Bay would run:

- Monday to Friday, from 5:30am until 11pm, every 15 minutes at peak commuting times and every 30 minutes at all other times.
- Weekends and public holidays, from 6am until 11pm, every 30 minutes.

#### Buses from Albany Village would run:

- Monday to Friday, from 6:30am until 11:30pm, every 15 minutes at peak commuting times and every 30 minutes at all other times.
- Weekends and public holidays, from 7am until 11:30pm, every 30 minutes.

# Any changes to bus services would be made when Rosedale Station opens.

Construction of the new station is due to start later in 2022 and is planned to be complete in early 2025.

Once the station is complete, Northern Busway services will stop at platforms spanning Rosedale Road, while local buses will stop at new bus stops on Rosedale Road. Pedestrians will access the station from Arrenway Drive and Rosedale Road.
